

My name is Nina Ahmad, and I am a candidate for the **President of the Pennsylvania Chapter of National Organization for Women (NOW).** I currently serve as the Interim Board President since April 2021, stepping up when the former President resigned before her term was over. I believe in the power of people to make positive change and am an advocate for equity for all. I am a first-generation American, scientist, former Deputy Mayor for Public Engagement for the City of Philadelphia where I was the first AAPI woman to hold a Cabinet position in any Philadelphia Administration. With a Doctorate in Chemistry from the University of Pennsylvania, I was an Assistant Professor and subsequently the Director of Molecular Biology of the Research Department at Wills Eye Hospital. I also co-founded JNA Capital, Inc., a

community development and real estate finance company where I serve as its Executive Vice President of Community Engagement.

I have been a successful civic leader who is unafraid to take on big fights. As former President of the Philadelphia NOW, I led a fight against the District Attorney's office that refused to fire three prosecutors who had e-mailed degrading pornographic images and rallied City Council to issue a resolution. During my tenure, we diversified the Board to become multigenerational, multiracial with diversity of gender and sexual orientation. As the Deputy Mayor, I fought workplace discrimination and harassment which undermines woman and people of color economically. As one of the few women of color Board member of the Philadelphia Foundation, I have helped provide millions of dollars to local non-profits aimed at fighting poverty and educating young people. President Obama appointed me to his Advisory Commission on AAPI and I was the 2016 Honoree of the Pennsylvania Immigration & Citizenship Coalition for my work facilitating civic participation of immigrants and refugees. I was recognized by City & State PA as one of the 50 of the most prominent and accomplished leaders in government, business and media over the age of 50 who make a positive impact on Pennsylvania. I was the first person of color, immigrant, and scientist to become the Democratic nominee for a statewide executive office in the 233 year-history of Pennsylvania. As the 2020 Democratic nominee for Auditor General of PA, I was the first woman of color to ever receive over three million votes statewide.

As a mother of two daughters, I am alarmed at the backward slide our country is experiencing with respect to women's rights. I want to be a part of the solution and push back against this "war on women" and believe if given the opportunity to serve as the President of PA NOW, I along with our members can make positive contributions to this effort as well as further the goals of NOW. I envision our statewide chapter being engaged in working to realize a broad vision for progress for women and their families.
